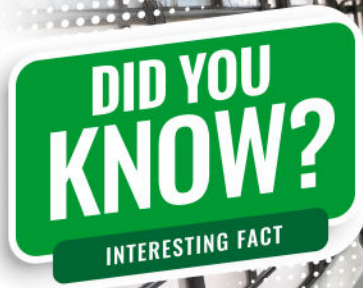

The career outlook is strong—ranked **#7 in healthcare jobs** and **#30 overall** by the U.S. News & World Report, with a **15% job growth projection (2022–2032)** per the **U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics (BLS, 2024)**.

Physical Therapy also ranks **#10 among the highest-paying U.S. healthcare jobs** in 2024, with a median salary of **\$97,720 (Php 5.5M)**.
