CAREER OUTLOOK

In 2023, approximately 13.7 million individuals were employed in U.S. business roles with a median salary of \$75,000 (BLS).

The global hospitality industry is rebounding with a 10.24% annual growth projected through 2028, creating many opportunities for graduates (Australian study).

In 2024, Travel & Tourism contributed US\$10.9 trillion to GDP, supported 357 million jobs, and is expected to add 91 million more by 2035, led by Asia-Pacific (WTTC).



Pre-qualification of ETEEAP Applicants

- Must be a Filipino citizen
- Must be at least 23 years old, with proof of age supported by a Philippine Statistics Authority (PSA) birth certificate
- Must be at least a high school graduate or possess a PEPT/ALS certification equivalent to first-year college standing
- Must have at least five years of relevant work experience in a field or industry related to the academic program for which they seek equivalency

Admission Requirements

- Accomplished Self-Assessment Form
- Accomplished ETEEAP Application Form
- Academic Record - Form 137 or original
- Transcript of Records
- Subject descriptions with learning competencies from the institution where applicant last enrolled in
- Certificate of Employment
- Duties and responsibilities in the various positions handled (signed by the HRD Manager or immediate unit manager)
- Five (5) pcs. of recent 1"x1" photo, white background
- PSA Birth Certificate
- Barangay clearance or NBI clearance or Passport
- Other documents such as but not limited:
 - Certificate of participation and/or attendance in seminars, trainings, conferences, colloquiums, or forums attended
 - Recognition, awards, and certificates
 - Relevant government examinations taken and passed
 - Local and international certifications
 - Copy of research and/or articles published
 - Certificate of professional membership
