BACHELOR OF SECONDARY EDUCATION (BSED)

A four-year program that prepares its students for the art and science of teaching. It builds know-how in pedagogy as well as would-be teachers' disciplinal expertise. Among the areas of specialization offered by the program are: English (Valenzuela City, Quezon City and Pampanga), Science (Pampanga), and Filipino (Pampanga).

BACHELOR OF ELEMENTARY EDUCATION (BEED)

A four-year program that provides academic and appropriate training for future elementary school teachers through the general education courses, professional education, and specialization courses. The program is offered in Valenzuela City, Quezon City, and Antipolo City Campuses.

BACHELOR OF EARLY CHILDHOOD EDUCATION (BECED)

A four-year program that prepares its students for both the art and science of teaching children 0-8 years old. It provides a solid basic foundation on developmentally appropriate practices in effective early childhood care and education. The program is offered in the Antipolo City Campus.

BACHELOR OF SPECIAL NEEDS EDUCATION (BSNED)

A four-year program that prepares students for the art and science of teaching children with special needs in the early years (birth through eight years old). It provides a solid foundation on developmentally appropriate practices in early childhood special needs intervention and education. The program is offered in the Antipolo City Campus.
